The Supreme Court criticised Election Commission software in West Bengal for deleting voters due to natural spelling variations. Justice Joymalya Bagchi called the restrictive software a 'tyrant' for ignoring cultural naming conventions.

Escalation in Ukhrul

Tensions flare between Kuki-Zo and Naga communities.

- **Location:** Litan Sareikhong area, Ukhrul District, Manipur.
- **Action:** Houses torched, villagers displaced.
- **Legal Response:** Prohibitory orders enforced under **Section 163** (BNSS).

Opposition parties consider a 'No-Confidence Motion' against Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla, alleging partisan conduct and suspension of MPs.

Anaemia
(Iron Deficiency) + HbA1c
Test = **Skewed
Results**

A new study in Lancet Regional Health warns that Anaemia can render the standard diabetes test (HbA1c) inaccurate. This is critical for India given the high prevalence of iron deficiency.




New Species Alert
