Supreme Court Highlights: The Decision Matrix



The Issue	The SC Ruling	Simple Takeaway
Appointing State Police Chiefs.	States must get Supreme Court consent if they delay sending their DGP candidate lists to the UPSC.	Stops states from bypassing the rules.
Making menstrual leave mandatory.	Refused to mandate it. Warned it could unintentionally harm women's hiring chances.	Left as a voluntary choice for State governments.
Over-reliance on traditional crops.	Asked the Union Government to revamp its policy to incentivize farmers.	Push to grow pulses instead of just wheat and paddy.

Explainer: The Right to Die Debate



The Case Study

Background: In 2013, 20-year-old student Harish Rana suffered a tragic fall, leaving him in a Persistent Vegetative State (PVS) for 13 years.

The Plea: His parents, after years of dedicated care with no improvement, asked the Supreme Court to withdraw life support so nature could take its course.



The Legal Question


The Debate: Does the Constitution's Right to Life (Article 21) inherently include the right to refuse medical treatment and die with dignity?

The Outcome: The SC refused to withdraw life support in this specific case, but it has sparked major national debates about medical autonomy, dignity, and constitutional morality.

Election Watch: The Upcoming Poll Dates

-  **Phase 1 (April 9):** Single-phase voting in Assam, Kerala, and Puducherry.
-  **Phase 2 & 3 (April 23 & 29):** Two-phase voting in West Bengal. (A major shift from their 8-phase election in 2021).
-  **Phase 2 (April 23):** Single-phase voting in Tamil Nadu.

Bypolls: 8 Assembly seats across various states (including Karnataka, Maharashtra, and Goa) will also hold bypolls.




State Highlights: Accords & Infrastructure



Assam's Peace Pacts

- **The Update:** The State Government signed a memorandum of settlement with three Kuki extremist groups and one Hmar group.
- **The Result:** Formation of dedicated Hmar and Kuki Welfare Development Councils to rehabilitate armed cadres.



Tamil Nadu's Gateway

- **The Update:** Madurai Airport (a historic 1942 airstrip) is officially upgraded to an International Terminal.
- **The Impact:** Facilitates direct flights to West Asia, Singapore, and Malaysia, serving the massive southern Tamil Nadu diaspora.

Cause & Effect: The LPG Panic Buying

Chain Reaction



The Trigger

Tensions in **West Asia** (Israel/Iran conflict) spark widespread rumors of impending oil and gas shortages.



The Reaction

Massive **panic-buying** across India. Daily LPG refill bookings spiked to 88.8 lakh before slightly cooling down to 77 lakh.



The Reality Check

The Government confirmed there is **NO** shortage. Refineries are running at high capacity, and India is fully self-sufficient in petrol/diesel production. Digital bookings are being used to curb the panic.

Global News: Tensions Escalate in West Asia

Israel's War Footing


The Israeli Cabinet approved a massive \$B27-million emergency budget allocation specifically for military purchases.

Gaza & Lebanon Strikes

Ongoing Israeli air strikes killed 9 Hamas police officers in Gaza. Simultaneously, Hezbollah targeted an Israeli air base near Tel Aviv, while Israeli strikes killed 4 in southern Lebanon.

The U.S. / Iran Factor

Former US President Trump claims Iran wants a deal, but simultaneously threatened to target Iran's Kharg Island oil hub.



India on the World Stage: Trade & Friction



Trade Friction with U.S.

The Action: The US government launched two official investigations against India.

The Accusation: Looking into policies that are allegedly unreasonable or discriminatory and restrict US commerce.



Building Bridges with EU


The Action: External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar is in Brussels.

The Goal: High-level talks with the European Union to finalize a landmark Free Trade Agreement (FTA) firmed up in January.

Meanwhile, the Congress party criticized the Centre's handling of the Chabahar Port project in Iran, calling it a strategic setback.

Science Update: ISRO's Glacier Warning

- **The Study:** ISRO scientists analyzed the devastating August 2025 flash floods that hit Dharali village in Uttarakhand.
- **The Finding:** Warming temperatures are rapidly degrading exposed ice patches on retreating Himalayan glaciers, creating severe flood risks.
- **The Solution:** ISRO stresses the critical need to continuously monitor these glaciers using high-resolution satellite images to provide early warnings and save lives.
