Top Story: Tensions Rise in the Middle East

The Trigger

What Happened: Ali Larijani (Secretary of Iran's Supreme National Security Council) was killed in a reported Israeli strike in Tehran.

US Fallout

Ripple Effect 1: U.S. Counterterrorism Chief Joe Kent abruptly resigns, stating he cannot in good conscience back the push for war, citing no imminent threat from Iran.

Global Impact

Ripple Effect 2: U.S. President Donald Trump delays a highly anticipated summit with China (originally meant to discuss trade and rare minerals) due to the escalating war crisis.

Neighbour Updates: Afghan-Pak Conflict Escalates



Afghanistan's Claim

- **The News:** A Pakistani airstrike hit the Omid Addiction Treatment Hospital (a 2,000-bed facility) in Kabul.
- **The Impact:** 400+ casualties reported. Termed a crime against humanity.



Pakistan's Claim

- **The Backstory:** Insists the strike precisely targeted Camp Phoenix, a former NATO base now allegedly used as a militant ammunition and equipment storage site.
- **The Stance:** Dismisses hospital casualty numbers as propaganda. ⚡



Legal Update: Maternity Leave Equality



The Ruling: The Supreme Court ruled that adoptive mothers are entitled to the exact same 12 weeks of paid maternity leave rights as biological mothers.

Key Quote: A child should not be deprived of her father's presence and a new mother her partner's companionship in the early phase of caregiving.

Why It Matters: Erases the legal distinction between biological and adoptive caregiving in the workplace.

National Security: NIA Operations



- **Who:** The National Investigation Agency (NIA) arrested one U.S. citizen and six Ukrainians.



- **Where:** Caught illegally crossing into Myanmar via the Mizoram border.



- **Why:** Suspected of attempting to train armed ethnic groups in weapons handling and drone warfare. (Social media posts threatened authoritarian regimes).

Update: Sonam Wangchuk Released



The News: Ladakh climate activist Sonam Wangchuk released after 170 days of detention under the **National Security Act (NSA)**.

His Stance: Stated that linguistic misunderstandings led to his detention.

The Takeaway: Called for mutual flexibility: Talks are a give-and-take process; both sides have to be flexible and considerate.


Economy Quick Fact: LPG Production Surge

38%



- **The Data:** Domestic production of LPG (cooking gas) has shot up by 38%.
- **The Target:** Production now hits over 48,000 tonnes on a daily basis.
- **The Catalyst:** The Centre issued new supply maintenance orders to artificially boost output and meet demand.

Kerala Note:


Congress releases its first list of 55 candidates for the Assembly polls (Includes actor Ramesh Pisharody).

West Bengal

Note: Trinamool Congress (TMC) names 291 candidates, dropping 74 sitting MLAs.

Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee to directly contest against BJP's Suwendu Adhikari in Bhabanipur.
