U.S. Stance

- Treasury Sec. suggests the U.S. may need to “escalate to de-escalate.”

Iran's Response

Threatens complete closure of the Strait and strikes on U.S./Israeli infrastructure.

- Specific Targets: Power plants, ICT infrastructure, and regional countries hosting U.S. bases.

Current Status: The strategic strait has been effectively closed to normal traffic since the start of the war.
