
Election Fever on the Ground



Kerala Campaign (BJP Focus)

- PM Modi rallies in Palakkad.
- Labels LDF and UDF the 'B-teams' of Kerala.
- Declares the BJP-led NDA as the real 'A-team'.

Accuses the LDF of plunging the state into a massive **₹5 Lakh Crore** debt.



Tamil Nadu Campaign (DMK Focus)

- CM M.K. Stalin releases the DMK's 'superstar' manifesto for the upcoming state elections.
- Focuses heavily on welfare and women-led development.

Promises an **₹8,000 coupon** for 'non-income tax paying' homemakers to purchase household appliances.

The MGNREGS Implementation Gap



The Centre introduces the VB-G RAM G Act, 2025 to replace the old rural employment framework.

District officials are caught in limbo—directed not to start new work under the old scheme, while the new scheme isn't fully operational.

Massive livelihood disruptions. In Muzaffarpur, Bihar, 12,000 workers have been left without work or pay for 3-4 months, leading to 87 days of ongoing protests.

India's Stance on the West Asia Crisis


“ Highlights from PM Modi's 'Mann Ki Baat' address:

- **The Situation:** Acknowledges the 'challenging times' in West Asia and warns of an emerging global crisis regarding petrol and diesel.
- **The Diaspora:** Expresses deep gratitude to Gulf nations for providing assistance and protection to over 1 Crore (10 million) Indians living in the region.
- **The Warning:** Urges citizens not to politicize the conflict and cautions against believing rumors.

The US-Iran-Pakistan Diplomatic Triangle

Parliament Speaker Ghalibaf warns the US against a ground invasion, stating forces are 'waiting to set them on fire.'

Eases Strait of Hormuz restrictions for 20 Pakistani ships.

Region	The Event	Global Impact
Israel / Lebanon	PM Netanyahu orders IDF to 'further expand' the northern security buffer zone.	Aimed at neutralizing Hezbollah anti-tank fire; Israeli strikes have hit ambulances, accusing militants of using them as cover.
North Korea 	Kim Jong-un oversees testing of an upgraded solid-fuel missile engine.	Significantly boosts ICBM (Intercontinental Ballistic Missile) agility and capability of reaching the US mainland.
Nepal 	Ex-PM K.P. Sharma Oli remanded in custody for 10 days.	Arrested in a money laundering probe connected to the recent 'Gen Z protests' involving burnt banknotes.

Insight:

A new FATF report praises India's Financial Intelligence Unit.

Action:

Leveraging Suspicious Activity Reports (STRs) to crack down on offshore Virtual Asset Service Providers (oVASPs) linked to money laundering and 'scam compounds'.

Railway Discipline (Efficiency)

Insight:

Indian Railways is enforcing strict budget discipline to curb unauthorized project expenditures.

Action:

The Railway Board orders General Managers to stop unsanctioned spending.
Recorded massive net savings of **₹27,193 crore** last fiscal year through tighter controls.

Science Spotlight: What is **exRNA**?



The Concept

Extracellular RNA (exRNA) refers to RNA strands that exist outside of human cells, floating freely in bodily fluids.

The Impact

It is revolutionizing modern diagnostics. Doctors can now detect complex conditions like cancer or heart disease simply by identifying specific RNA patterns in a basic blood or fluid test.
