

# CHECKLIST TO AVOID CLAT 2024 MISHAPS

## Pre-Examination Preparations:

- ☐ Brush up the official CLAT 2024 Exam Day Instructions set by the Consortium.
- ☐ Familiarize yourself with both the Code of Conduct and Medical protocols.

## Essential Documents:

- ☐ Ensure you have your CLAT Admit Card.
- ☐ Bring government ID proof for verification (like Aadhaar Card, Passport, PAN card, etc.).
- ☐ If using a scribe, have an SAP (PwD) certificate on hand.

## Arrival and Time Management:

- ☐ Aim to reach the exam center at least one hour before the exam.
- ☐ Remember that entry into the exam hall is prohibited after 15 minutes from the start of the examination.
- ☐ Understand the CLAT bell timings to manage your time during the exam effectively.

## General Rules and Behavior:

- ☐ Deposit mobile phones at the designated location.
- ☐ Sign the admit card in the presence of the invigilator.
- ☐ Strictly avoid copying, receiving assistance, or assisting others.

## Medical Protocols:

- ☐ Participate in the thermal screening process at the exam center gate.
- ☐ Maintain social distancing at all times.
- ☐ Do not form groups inside the exam hall.
- ☐ Carry and use hand sanitizers but avoid spilling on OMR sheets.
- ☐ Wear face masks/shields throughout and ensure you have an N95 mask if arriving with a scribe.

## Dress Code and Appearance:

- ☐ Follow the specific CLAT dress code, prioritizing comfortable and decent attire.
- ☐ Wear approved footwear (preferably slippers or sandals).
- ☐ Minimize accessories; especially avoid flashy or potentially distracting items.
- ☐ Dress appropriately for the weather.

## Allowed and Prohibited Items:

- ☐ Review the list of allowed items, such as slippers, sandals, half T-shirts, etc.
- ☐ Familiarize yourself with the items not allowed, like shoes, watches, sunglasses, etc.
- ☐ Ensure that you're not carrying any banned items like food, electronic devices, or unapproved stationery.

**Misconduct and Consequences:**

- ☐ Avoid causing any disruptions at the exam center.
- ☐ Stay away from behaviors that can lead to disqualification, such as using banned items or misbehaving.
- ☐ Understand the consequences of misconduct, including possible disqualification.

**Special Guidelines for PWDs & SAPs:**

- ☐ If applicable, be aware of the extended exam time.
- ☐ Ensure you have your original Disability Certificate.
- ☐ Make arrangements for a scribe if needed and understand the guidelines regarding this provision.

**Final Reminders:**

- ☐ Stay calm and focused.
- ☐ Use your knowledge and preparation to confidently answer the exam questions.
- ☐ Ensure to follow all the guidelines and rules for a smooth exam experience.
