KEY THINGS TO REVISE IN THE LAST 10 DAYS FOR CLAT 2024

- Avoid New Topics: Do not start new topics in any subject.
- **Reading Routine:** Dedicate 60-90 minutes daily to reading editorials, genre-specific articles (four different genres), and five topics from the LegaLEdge topics list.
- Mock Tests: Take three mock tests each week and perform a detailed analysis. Identify
 mistakes and work on improving them.
- Current Affairs Revision: Complete the second round of current affairs revision by November 30th.
- One-liner Current Affairs: Revise current affairs one-liners within a single day.
- Newspaper Reading: Stop reading the newspaper for current affairs after November 15th.
- Strategy and Content Limitation: Focus on refining your strategy and limit the study content.
- **Key to Success:** Emphasize revision and practice as your primary tools now.
- **Data Interpretation (DI) Sets:** Revise 50 DI sets from RSMs, previous mocks, and GMB within these 10 days.
- **English Preparation:** For English, focus on revising Reading Comprehension (RC) tones, Figures of Speech, Idioms, and grammar rules.
- Mock Analysis: Revisit and revise takeaways from previous mock analyses and implement the learnings.
- Mock Test Limit: Do not attempt more than one mock test per day.
- **Legal Knowledge:** Stay updated with current legal knowledge topics trending in November and revise the topics covered in the last 11 months.
