Indo-US task force set up to elevate electronics trade to \$100 bln in next decade

- In a remarkable endeavor to strengthen trade relations between India and the United States within the electronics sector, the Indian Cellular & Electronics Association (ICEA) has established a dedicated task force. With a goal to elevate the current Indo-US electronics trade, currently at \$8 billion, to an ambitious \$100 billion within the next decade, this initiative follows collaborative efforts initiated after Prime Minister Narendra Modi's state visit to the United States last month.
- Ambitious Trade Target: ICEA Chairman Pankaj Mohindroo emphasized that achieving this
 monumental goal would significantly bolster India's aspirations to become a global hub for
 innovation and manufacturing in the electronics sector.
- Comprehensive Representation: ICEA, serving as the apex industry body, represents the entire
 electronics ecosystem in India, including components, subassemblies, EMS (Electronic
 Manufacturing Services), and finished goods across various Electronic System Design and
 Manufacturing (ESDM) verticals, such as mobile phones, consumer electronics, and IT hardware.
- The establishment of the Critical and Emerging Technology (iCET) is a pivotal component of this initiative. It will facilitate cooperation in futuristic domains, including artificial intelligence, quantum computing, space exploration, semiconductors, and defense technology.

Union Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia Inaugurates Utkela Airport In Odisha With Maiden Flight

- On August 31, 2023, Union Civil Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia, accompanied by Gen Vijay Kumar Singh (Retd), Minister of State for Civil Aviation, marked a significant milestone with the inauguration of Utkela Airport in Odisha. This development comes as part of the ambitious UDAN (Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik) scheme, aimed at enhancing regional air connectivity across India.
- The key highlight of this inauguration is the introduction of a direct flight route between Utkela and Bhubaneshwar. This air link promises to strengthen regional connectivity and stimulate economic growth within the region.
- Travel between Utkela and Bhubaneshwar will now be remarkably efficient, with the flight covering the distance in just one hour and twenty minutes. Minister Scindia emphasized that this improved connectivity would catalyze economic activities and create employment prospects in the area.

Aditya-L1: Significance behind name, objectives of India's first solar mission

 The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is set to embark on a groundbreaking space mission, Aditya L-1, designed to unravel the mysteries of our closest star, the Sun. Scheduled for launch from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota on Saturday, September 2nd, at 11:50 am, this mission promises to shed light on the enigmatic solar processes that impact our planet and the wider cosmos.



• The "L1" in Aditya L-1 stands for Lagrange point 1, a celestial location nestled precisely between the Sun and Earth. Lagrange points are regions where the gravitational forces of two massive objects, in this case, the Sun and Earth, balance each other, allowing a spacecraft to essentially "hover" in place.

Manish Desai assumes charge of Principal Director General PIB

- The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting has made significant appointments, including the transfer of Manish Desai, the Central Bureau of Communications (CBC) chief, to lead the Press Information Bureau (PIB).
- Manish Desai, a distinguished officer of the Indian Information Service (IIS) since 1989, has taken
 on several critical roles in his career. He held the position of CBC chief, overseeing the
 government's advertising and public communication arm. His responsibilities encompassed a
 broad spectrum of communication activities across various media platforms, including print,
 electronic, outdoor, transit, and new media.
- From November 2019 to January 2020, Manish Desai served as the Director General of the Registrar of Newspapers of India (RNI). Additionally, he has an impressive six-year tenure as the Additional Director General (ADG) of PIB from 2012 to 2018. He has also held the position of Director General of the West Zone PIB in Mumbai.

- The other two nominees in the category were Fernando Padula Novaes, Municipal Minister of Education of Sao Paulo in Brazil and Saif Al-Hiddabi, Undersecretary of Research and Innovation at Ministry of Higher Education, Research, and Innovation in Oman.
- Shanta Thoutam completed 7 years of her service in the innovation ecosystem of Telangana starting with the role of Vice President at T-Hub, then Officer on Special Duty (OSD) for State Handlooms and Textiles Department, and currently serving as the first woman CIO.
- With over 30 countries' representatives at the first-of-its-kind forum, Shanta Thoutam as one of
 the panelists in the Cloud City Conference enlightened about the various pathbreaking initiatives
 and achievements of the government of Telangana in the space of open data, digital innovation,
 and urban development.

UPI crosses 10 billion transactions for the first time in August

- The Unified Payments Interface (UPI) in India has achieved a significant milestone by surpassing 10 billion monthly transactions in August. This achievement was confirmed by the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI), the Reserve Bank's non-profit agency. UPI has been a key driver of digital payments in India, and its rapid growth is noteworthy.
- In August, UPI recorded an impressive milestone of 10 billion monthly transactions, as confirmed by NPCI. This signifies the increasing popularity and adoption of digital payments in India.
- UPI's growth trajectory has been remarkable, with monthly transactions exceeding 10.24 billion by the end of August. This represents a significant increase from the 6.58 billion transactions recorded in August of the previous year, marking a growth rate of over 50% year-on-year.
- UPI's journey began in October 2019 when it crossed 1 billion monthly transactions for the first time. In less than four years, it has grown fourfold, showcasing its rapid adoption and acceptance in the Indian payment landscape.

Moody's raises India's GDP growth estimates for 2023 to 6.7%

- Global rating agency Moody's Investor Service has revised its economic growth projection for India, providing a positive outlook for the year 2023. The agency has increased its forecast for India's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth to 6.7 percent, up from the previous estimate of 5.5 percent. This adjustment is attributed to the notable performance in the second quarter, driven by robust expansion in services and capital expenditures, resulting in a 7.8 percent real GDP growth compared to the previous year.
- Initial Forecast: Moody's previously estimated India's GDP growth for 2023 at 5.5 percent.
- Revised Projection: The agency has raised its forecast to 6.7 percent for 2023 due to strong services expansion and capital expenditures, driving a 7.8 percent real GDP growth in the second quarter of the year.

Centre, states collect ₹1.59 trillion in GST in August

 In August, India witnessed a notable surge in Goods and Services Tax (GST) collection, amounting to ₹1.59 trillion, signifying an 11% increase compared to the same period last year. This impressive growth can be attributed to enhanced compliance and anti-evasion measures put in place.



- August 2023's collection marked a significant rise from the ₹1.43 trillion collected in August 2022.
- However, it's important to note that GST collection moderated compared to the previous month, which recorded ₹1.65 trillion in July.
- The moderation in collection is primarily attributed to subdued growth in integrated GST (IGST) and the cess on imports, which increased by only 3% in August.
- Importantly, both imports and IGST collections have experienced fluctuations in recent months.

Gabon officers declare military coup, President Ali Bongo detained

- Gabon, an oil-producing country in Central Africa, has experienced a coup led by military officers.
 President Ali Bongo was placed under house arrest after being declared the winner of a disputed
 election. This marks the eighth coup in West and Central Africa since 2020, reflecting a trend of
 democratic setbacks in the region. Other countries like Mali, Guinea, Burkina Faso, and Chad
 have also witnessed military takeovers, raising concerns for regional stability and foreign
 interests.
- Military officers announced the seizure of power, canceling election results and dissolving state institutions.
- The officers declared President Bongo's victory invalid and placed him under house arrest.
- General Brice Oligui Nguema was appointed as the new leader through a unanimous vote by generals.

Russia Launches Islamic Banking Pilot Program in Bid for Economic Diversification

- Russia is set to embark on a historic journey by launching its first Islamic banking pilot program
 on September 1. With a considerable Muslim population of approximately 25 million, the move
 aims to tap into the potential of Islamic finance, which has already had a presence through
 institutions but lacked official recognition. President Vladimir Putin's recent endorsement of the
 initiative signifies a significant step towards embracing Islamic banking principles in the country.
 Features of Islamic Banking-
 - 1. Shariah Compliance and Ethical Framework: Islamic banking operates on the principles of Shariah, the Islamic legal system that prohibits usurious transactions and interest charges due to their perceived injustice. This fundamental difference sets it apart from conventional banking practices.
 - 2. Asset-based Model and Partnership Structure: Conventional finance relies on debt-based transactions, where clients bear the entire risk and liability. In contrast, Islamic banking is grounded in an asset-based approach, emphasizing shared profits and risks between financial institutions and clients through partnership arrangements.
 - 3. Socially Responsible Investments: One of the significant distinctions is Islamic banking's avoidance of sectors deemed harmful to society, such as alcohol, tobacco, and gambling. This ethical stance aligns with the principles of Shariah, promoting responsible financial practices.
 - 4. Prohibition of Speculation and Risky Transactions: Unlike conventional finance, Islamic banking disallows financing speculation, financial derivatives, and deals lacking tangible assets. This



prohibition aims to mitigate risks and prevent financial crises akin to the global economic downturn.

Piyush Goyal unveils statue of First Finance Minister of Independent India RK Shanmugam Chetty in Coimbatore

- In an event organized by the South Indian Panchayat Association in Coimbatore, Piyush Goyal, the Union Minister of Textiles, inaugurated the statue of RK Shanmugam Chetty, who served as the first Finance Minister of independent India.
- Commencing the event, a statue paying homage to RK Shanmugam Chetty, a pivotal figure in India's historical narrative and a significant administrator within the South Indian Panchayat Association, was unveiled.
- This statue now resides within the esteemed confines of the South Indian Panchayat Sangha complex, situated in the Racecourse area of Coimbatore. This act not only served as a tribute to Chetty's remarkable contributions but also as a lasting homage to his enduring legacy, which remains a source of inspiration and guidance to this day.
- Ramasamy Chetty Kandasamy Shanmukham Chetty, known as R.K. Shanmukham Chetty, was a
 prominent Indian lawyer, economist, and politician who played a pivotal role in the early years of
 independent India. He held significant positions in both government and academia during his
 distinguished career.

Cabinet okays Rs 5k cr PRIP scheme to boost research and innovation

- The Union Health Ministry has announced an ambitious plan to boost research and innovation in the pharmaceutical and medtech sectors. To achieve this goal, they have introduced the Promotion of Research & Innovation in Pharma-MedTech sector (PRIP) scheme, which has been approved by the Union Cabinet. The scheme was rolled out earlier this month by the government with the belief that the Indian pharmaceutical industry has the potential to increase its current 3.4 per cent share of the global market to 5 per cent by the year 2030.
- The Union Health Ministry has announced a plan to invest ₹700 crore in creating seven Centres of Excellence at various National Institutes of Pharmaceutical, Education & Research (NIPER) to boost research and innovation in the pharma and medtech sector.
- The scheme, called Promotion of Research & Innovation in Pharma-MedTech sector (PRIP), will be launched in September and will have a duration of five years, from 2023-24 to 2027-28.
- The Centre will also provide ₹4,250 crore to support research in the private sector through milestone-based funding. The Centre may also acquire equity stakes of 5-10% in these private entities in exchange for the funding.
- The scheme aims to enhance the capacity of PSUs and encourage private sector participation in research.

Government To Celebrate Sixth Rashtriya Poshan Maah 2023 throughout September

• The Ministry of Women and Child Development is celebrating the 6th Rashtriya Poshan Maah throughout September 2023. This year, the objective is to comprehensively tackle malnutrition through a life-cycle approach.



- The focal point of Poshan Maah 2023 is to cultivate widespread awareness concerning critical human life stages: pregnancy, infancy, childhood, and adolescence. The aim is to foster nutritional understanding across India through a theme centered on "Suposhit Bharat, Sakshar Bharat, Sashakt Bharat" (Nutrition-rich India, Educated India, Empowered India).
- The Government of India's flagship initiative, POSHAN Abhiyaan, has been instrumental in advancing nutritional outcomes for pregnant women, lactating mothers, adolescent girls, and children under 6 years of age in a comprehensive manner.
- Launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister, POSHAN (Prime Minister's Overarching Scheme for Holistic Nutrition) Abhiyaan operates in mission mode to combat the challenge of malnutrition.
- During the 15th Financial Commission period, Poshan Abhiyaan, the Anganwadi Services Scheme, and the Scheme for Adolescent Girls were aligned under Mission Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0 to launch an integrated nutrition support programme aimed at strengthening content, delivery, outreach, and outcomes.

Bhaderwah rajmash, Ramban Sulai honey get GI tag

- In a significant development for the region, Bhaderwah Rajmash and Sulai honey, both hailing from the picturesque districts of Doda and Ramban in Jammu and Kashmir, have been granted coveted Geographical Indication (GI) tags. These tags serve as a testament to the unique qualities and characteristics of these local specialties and open up doors for their promotion and recognition on an international scale.
- Bhaderwah Rajmash, often referred to as red beans holds a special place in the hearts and palates of those in the Chenab Valley. With its distinct flavor and texture, this legume is not only a staple food item but also a cultural symbol of the region.

India's largest home-built Kakrapar Nuclear Plant in Gujarat starts operations at full capacity, says PM Modi

- In a significant development for India's energy sector, Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced that the 700 MW nuclear power plant located in Kakrapar, Gujarat, has commenced its operations at maximum capacity. This milestone marks a pivotal moment in India's quest for energy self-sufficiency and underscores the nation's commitment to harnessing indigenous nuclear technology.
- The Kakrapar Atomic Power Project (KAPP) had initiated its commercial operations on June 30, 2023, but initially operated at only 90 percent of its capacity. On August 31, 2023, the plant finally achieved its full operational potential.
- The Kakrapar Nuclear Power Plant is a testament to India's capability in developing and
 operating nuclear power facilities entirely on its own. The Nuclear Power Corporation of India
 Limited (NPCIL) has been at the forefront of this endeavor.

In 5-year deal, Viacom 18 bags BCCI TV and digital media rights for Rs 5,963 crore

- Viacom 18, a Reliance-owned media outlet, has emerged victorious in the auction for media rights, encompassing both digital and TV broadcasting, of India's domestic matches and BCCIhosted domestic tournaments for the next five years. The auction took place on August 31, 2023. This significant acquisition complements Viacom 18's existing digital rights for the Indian Premier League (IPL) and the FIFA World Cup rights for India. Let's delve deeper into the details.
- Viacom 18 faced fierce competition from Sony Sports Network and Star Sports in the bidding process. Star Sports already held TV rights for ICC events and the IPL, leaving Sony to vie for these coveted rights.
- For the 88 matches scheduled between 2023 and 2028, the BCCI set a base price of Rs 20 crore per match for TV rights and Rs 25 crore per match for digital rights, totaling Rs 3,960 crore.

- Aim: To enable faster, more reliable, and contactless payments for everyday small value purchases, transit payments, and so on by eliminating the need for two-factor verification for small value transactions.
- This effectively means that transacting parties can carry out digital transactions amounting to ₹500 each in the offline mode.
