67th TAAI Convention held in Colombo

- The highly anticipated 67th Travel Agents Association of India (TAAI) Convention commence begin on July 8 in Colombo. The three-day convention's inaugural ceremony promises to be a star-studded affair with the esteemed presence of Sri Lanka's President Ranil Wickremasinghe, and High Commissioner of India Gopal Baglay among others.
- The convention presents numerous trade opportunities for Indian and Sri Lankan travel industry stakeholders. With 500 participants and 50 Indian media personnel, the event solidifies its position as a premier travel event in the region. The convention's agenda features a range of thought-provoking sessions, including discussions on India's tourism vision for 2047, the rise of experiential travel, the growing significance of MICE (Meetings, Incentives, Conferences, and Exhibitions), and the ever-expanding digital opportunities in the travel industry.

Defence ministry, HAL sign ₹458 cr contract for two upgraded Dornier aircraft for coast guard

- The Ministry of Defence on Friday signed a contract with Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) for the procurement of two Dornier aircraft for the Indian Coast Guard (ICG) along with an associated engineering support package at an overall cost of ₹458.87 crore.
- The aircraft will be procured under the 'Buy (Indian) Category', the ministry said in a statement. It added that the aircraft will be fitted with several advanced equipment including a glass cockpit, maritime patrol radar, electro-optic infrared device, and mission management system.
- "The addition will further bolster the aerial surveillance capability of maritime areas of responsibilities of the ICG," the ministry said.
- "The Dornier aircraft are being indigenously manufactured at HAL (Transport Aircraft Division), Kanpur and will significantly contribute in achieving Aatmanirbharta in defence, in consonance with the 'Make in India' initiative of the government," it added
- Raksha Mantri Rajnath Singh launches a single window NCC Integrated Software for Cadets



- In a major step towards promoting digitisation and in sync with Digital India mission, Raksha Mantri Shri Rajnath Singh launched an NCC Integrated Software in New Delhi on 07 July 2023. The NCC Integrated Software, developed in partnership with Bhaskaracharya Institute for Space Applications and Geo Informatics (BISAG), is a single window interactive software for Cadets, designed on the 'Entry to Exit Model'.
- The NCC Integrated Software is based on the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's vision of "Once a Cadet always a cadet", and will digitalize the entire process from the stage of enrolment.
- as a cadet in NCC till exit registration as alumni. This will enable seamless issue of certificates, creation of an all India database of NCC cadets at the time of their employment.
- During this event, the NCC and State Bank of India (SBI) also signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in the presence of Raksha Mantri to open zero balance accounts of all NCC Cadets with debit card, chequebook & passbook facility under SBI's "Pahli Udaan" scheme. About 5 lakh cadets will be benefitted by this MoU every year.
- The account will remain functional till completion of training or attaining 18 years of age whichever is later. This will not only introduce the cadets to the national banking system but also provide them with a ready platform to avail benefit of other govt schemes through DBT (Direct Benefit Transfer) of funds into their accounts.

Shravani Mela inaugurated in Deogha Jharkhand

- Shravani Mela, one of the largest religious congregations in the country's eastern region, was inaugurated in Jharkhand's Deoghar district on Monday. State Agriculture Minister Badal Patralekh inaugurated the fair at Kanwariyapath in Dumma, bordering Bihar. Usually, the mela is organised for a month during the month of 'Shravan', according to the Saka Calendar. This year, the fair will be organised for two consecutive months from July 3 to August 31.
- Devotees from various parts of the country and abroad visit Deoghar during the
 month of 'Shravan' and offer prayers at Baba Baidyanath Dham temple. The journey
 ends with the pilgrims pouring the holy water on the 'shivalingam' at the Baba
 Baidyanath Dham temple. This year, the number of devotees may double compared
 to previous years. The government as well as the Deoghar administration has made
 proper arrangements for the pilgrims,
- To accommodate the vast number of attendees, the Deoghar administration has made significant arrangements. Facilities such as drinking water, toilets, electricity, and cleanliness have been prioritized to ensure the well-being of the pilgrims. In addition, the establishment of 27 police outposts enhances crowd management and maintains a secure environment within the fair premises.

PM Narendra Modi inaugurated development projects worth over 6000 crore rupees in Warangal, Telangana

• Prime Minister Narendra Modi will layed the foundation stone of several infrastructure projects in Warangal, Telangana this morning July 8. He will arrive at Hakimpet Airport Station by a special flight from Varanasi to reach Warangal. After



- visiting famous Bhadrakali Temple, the Prime Minister will lay the foundation stone of infrastructure works worth over 6000 crore rupees in a virtual mode. He will also address a public meeting from the Arts College Grounds, Hanmakonda.
- Prime Minister also layed the stone for the hundred and eight -km long Mancherial-Warangal section of the Nagpur-Vijayawada Corridor, which will reduce the distance by about 34 km on two national highways. He will also lay the stone for the upgradation of the 68-km long Karimnagar-Warangal section from the existing two-lane to four-lanes. This will help in improving connectivity to Hyderabad-Warangal Industrial Corridor, Kakatiya Mega Textile Park, and the special economic zone at Warangal. The Prime Minister will also lay the foundation stone to the Railway Manufacturing Unit at Kazipet, which will improve the manufacturing
- capacity and also job opportunities to the local youth. The Prime Minister's visit assumes significance as Telangana state is going for Assembly polls in the next few months.

Legendary artist, illustrator and sculptor Namboothiri passes away at 97

- The famous illustrator, sculptor and line sketch artist, KM Vasudevan Namboothiri, passed away at the age of 97. KM Vasudevan took his last breath at a private hospital in Kottakkal on Friday, where he was going through treatment for his agerelated ailments.
- During his decades-long career, Namboothiri illustrated many popular characters for literary publications in the state. He has done some really popular literary works, which include characters of doyens of Malayalam literature like Jnanpith laureates M T Vasudevan Nair, Thakazhi Sivasankara Pillai and S K Pottakkad and legends like Vaikom Muhammad Basheer.
- Namboothiri early life Namboothiri was born in 1925 in Kerala's Ponnani. He
 entered the world of painting and sculpture in his childhood as he was influenced by
 a temple near his house. He was the disciple of prominent artist K C S Paniker and he
 was also inspired by renowned painters like Debi Prasad Roy Chowdhury and S
 Dhanapal.
- Namboothiri studied painting at the Madras School of Fine Arts.
- He also tried his hands at art direction and worked as an art director in a few films, such as Uttarayanam, which won him Kerala State Award for the best art director.
- In his long career of more than fifty years, he has done illustrations for almost all important literary works.

Major Bakhtawar Singh Brar, one of oldest Army veterans, passes away at 109

- Major Bakhtawar Singh Brar (retd), one of the oldest veterans of the Kumaon Regiment in the Indian Army, passed away on Monday in the US. He was 109. The news about Major Brar's death was tweeted by author Jai Samota and confirmed by Colonel NN Bhatia (retd), a veteran of the Kumaon Regiment who is well-versed in the history of the regiment
- Born in November 1913 in Faridkot district, Major Brar served in the Faridkot State Forces and then joined the 6 Kumaon Regiment, before retiring in 1963.



- In 1934, Major Brar joined the State Forces of Maharaja of Faridkot. He was awarded the Mention-in-Despatches by the King of England in 1942 for leading his company against the Pathans in Waziristan
- Major Brar was commissioned into the 6 Kumaon Regiment in 1945 and saw action in World War II in Burma. On November 8, 1957, he was tasked with snow clearance in the rescue operation in Baltal and was again awarded Mention-in-Despatches.
- In 1959, he led a contingent of 6 Kumaon at the Republic Day Parade. He also received the Chief of Army Staff 'Commendation Card' for his service in Jammu and Kashmir in 1960. In March 1960, he was posted to the 111 Infantry Battalion (TA).

RBI appoints P. Vasudevan as new executive director

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Thursday appointed P. Vasudevan as executive director. His appointment is effective from July 03, 2023.
- The Reserve Bank in a statement said Vasudevan will look after Department of Currency Management, Corporate Strategy and Budget Department (Areas other than that of Budget & Funds) and Enforcement Department.
- Prior to being promoted as executive director, Vasudevan was the Chief General Manager-in-charge of the Department of Payment and Settlement Systems.
- The apex bank said Vasudevan has, over a span of nearly 30 years in the Reserve Bank, served in supervision of banks and non-banking financial companies, payment and settlement systems and other areas in the Reserve Bank, including a stint as Member of Faculty in Bankers' Training College.

National Water Mission Inks MoU with Indian Plumbing Association To Improve Water Use Efficiency

- A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed today between Bureau of Water Use Efficiency (BWUE), National Water Mission (NWM), Ministry of Jal Shakti and Indian Plumbing Association (IPA) for a Water Positive India by awareness creation & promotion of rain water harvesting structures, low flow fixtures & sanitary ware, treatment of grey & black water, water audit of built environment. The MoU was signed by Ms. Archana Varma, Additional Secretary & Mission Director, on behalf of National Water Mission, Ministry of Jal Shakti and Shri Gurmit Singh Arora, National President, Indian Plumbing Association based in Okhla, New Delhi.
- Speaking on the occasion, Ms. Archana Varma, Additional Secretary & Mission
 Director, National Water Mission asserted that today is the historic day for Bureau of
 Water Use Efficiency as the IPA has been actively promoting fixtures that are water
 sensitive and consume less water and the MoU would help in promoting its objective
 of increasing water use efficiency.
- Shri Gurmeet Arora, National President, Indian Plumbing Association added that his
 organization would give full cooperation for increasing water use efficiency in
 domestic sector by 50-60% (reducing water use from 135 lpcd to 60 lpcd). He further
 stressed water audit for built environments (residential buildings, hotels etc.) to
 achieve the target of Net Zero Water Buildings.

India-UK Electric Propulsion Technical Workshop held in New Delhi

Indian Navy and US Navy Conduct SALVEX Exercise in Kochi

The Seventh edition of Indian Navy – US Navy (IN – USN) Salvage and Explosive
Ordnance Disposal (EOD) exercise, SALVEX was conducted from 26 Jun – 06 Jul 23 at
Kochi. IN and USN have been participating in joint Salvage and EOD exercises since
2005. The exercise saw participation from both the navies which included the ships –
INS Nireekshak and USNS Salvor in addition to Specialist Diving and EOD teams.



- Spanning over 10 days, the Diving teams of both the countries shared experiences on Maritime Salvage and trained together in various facets of EOD Operations on land as well at sea. SALVEX also saw conduct of joint training exercises towards enhancing interoperability, cohesiveness and gaining from best practices mutually in Maritime Salvage and EOD operations.
- The constructive engagements on operational terms enhanced the skill-sets of the Diving teams in a number of diverse disciplines such as mine detection and neutralisation, wreck location and salvage.

Amit Shah lays foundation stone of first co-operative-run Sainik School in Gujarat

- Union Home and Cooperation Minister Amit Shah organized a virtual ceremony to lay
 the foundation stone of the country's first cooperative-run Sainik School. This event
 took place near Mehsana in Gujarat. Sainik Schools are being established in honor of
 Prime Minister Narendra Modi's appeal to start 100 new Sainik Schools on PPP basis
 across India. This Sainik School, run by a cooperative, is a symbol of the
 government's commitment to include various sectors in the development of the
 country.
- The Sainik School will be set up in Boriyavi village, located about 11 km from Mehsana city in Gujarat. Leading cooperative organisation Dudhsagar Dairy is starting this project at a cost of Rs 75 crore. The virtual foundation stone laying ceremony was attended by Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel and several senior cabinet ministers.

Bangladesh captain Tamim Iqbal shocking retirement

- Bangladesh one-day captain Tamim Iqbal announced his shock retirement from international cricket on Thursday, three months before the team begins its 50-overs World Cup campaign in India.
- The 34-year-old was in tears as he announced his decision to end his 16-year international career in a news conference.
- angladesh, whose World Cup campaign begins on October 7 against Afghanistan in Dharamsala, is yet to reveal who will lead the side after Tamim's exit.
- A leading contender is Shakib Al Hasan, who captains the T20 side. Left-handed opener Tamim has scored 15,000-plus runs in international cricket, including 25 centuries.
- His ODI tally of 8,313 runs is the highest by a Bangladesh batsman and his 14 centuries in this format is also higher than any of his compatriots.
- Tamim skipped the one-off Test against Afghanistan last month with a stiff back and scored 13 in Wednesday's one-day international against Afghanistan in Chattogram, in what turned out his last international outing.

- Shri Singh-I graduated from Allahabad University in 1975. Passed out as a Law graduate from Allahabad University in the year 1978. Joined judicial service in 1984 and worked as District Judge, Registrar (Judicial) in various districts of Uttar Pradesh. He was appointed Supervisor of Ram Janmabhoomi, Ayodhya, Faizabad. He was elevated as a judge in Allahabad and served there till January 2018.

Kiswahili Language Day

- In the 1950s the United Nations established the Kiswahili language unit of United Nations Radio, and today Kiswahili is the only African language within the Directorate of the Global Communications at the United Nations. The United Nations General Assembly, through its resolution 71/328 of 11 September 2017, on multilingualism, welcomed implementation of a day dedicated to each of its official languages in order to inform and raise awareness of their history, culture and use, and encouraged the Secretary-General and institutions such as UNESCO to consider extending this important initiative to other non-official languages spoken throughout the world.
- In that regard, the 41st session of the General Conference of UNESCO adopted resolution 41 C/61 that recognized the role the Kiswahili language plays in promoting cultural diversity, creating awareness and fostering dialogue among civilizations and noted the need to promote multilingualism as a core value of the United Nations and an essential factor in harmonious communication between peoples, which promotes unity in diversity and international understanding, tolerance and dialogue. The resolution proclaimed 7 July of each year as World Kiswahili Language Day. Kiswahili is the first African language to the recognized in such a manner by the UN.
- World Kiswahili Language Day 2023: Unleashing Kiswahili's potential in the digital era. The second commemoration of the World Kiswahili Language Day will highlight the important role played by Kiswahili in the digital landscape

Urban-20 Mayoral Summit begins in Ahmedabad and Gandhinagar in Gujarat today, July7

- The Urban 20 (U20) Mayoral Summit will begin today in the twin cities of Ahmedabad and Gandhinagar. Delegates and participants from 57 cities across the world and 35 cities from India will participate in the two-day summit. U20 is an Engagement Group under India's G20 presidency. Gujarat Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel and Minister of State for Housing and Urban Affairs Kaushal Kishore will inaugurate the summit.
- Akashvani correspondent reports that thematic sessions on the six U20 priority areas
 including environmental responsibility, climate finance, and water security will be
 organized during the summit. Mayors from across the world and Indian cities will

 participants, including Mayors, Deputy Mayors, city officials, and knowledge
 partners will attend the summit.
- The event will also host an exhibition showcasing India's urban story, especially city-level success, notable projects, and innovative initiatives. The key outcome of the U20 Mayoral Summit is the handover of the U20 Communiqué by the attending Mayors to the G20 leaders. The U20 Communiqué is an action-oriented collaboratively prepared document that brings to the fore the role that cities can play in taking forward the G20 agenda.

India to set up first IIT campus abroad in Zanzibar, Tanzania

- An MoU has been signed to set up the IIT Madras campus in Tanzania. External
 Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar is on a visit to Tanzania and witnessed the signing
 of this MoU.
- The External Affairs Minister tweeted that he witnessed the signing of the agreement on the establishment of the IIT Madras Zanzibar campus. He also appreciated the President Hussain Ali and his ministers for gracing the occasion. This historic step shows India's commitment to the Global South (developing countries).
- In addition, the External Affairs Minister and the President of Zanzibar attended the Deck Reception held onboard INS Trishul. He welcomed the presence of the Speaker of Parliament, ministers, parliamentarians, senior officers of the Tanzania Defence Forces, and the Indian diaspora to grace the occasion.
- Earlier, in the month of February, 2023, a delegation of the Indian Institute of Technology- Madras, had visited Tanzania to set up the first IIT offshore campus in the African continent. This kind of campus can be instrumental in the growth and the nation building of not only Tanzania but of the whole continent.

Indian Navy hosts 7th edition of bilateral Japan-India Maritime Exercise 2023 - (JIMEX 23)

- The seventh edition of the bilateral Japan-India Maritime Exercise 2023 (JIMEX 23) hosted by the Indian Navy, is being conducted at/off Visakhapatnam from 05-10 July 2023. This edition marks the 11th anniversary of JIMEX, since its inception in 2012.
- Japan Maritime Self Defence Force (JMSDF) units under the command of RAdm Nishiyama Takahiro, Commander Escort Flotilla One, and Indian Naval ships under the command of RAdm Gurcharan Singh, Flag Officer Commanding Eastern Fleet are participating in the exercise.
- JIMEX 23 will witness the participation of INS Delhi, India's first indigenously built Guided Missile Destroyer, INS Kamorta, an indigenously designed and built Anti-Submarine Warfare Corvette, fleet tanker INS Shakti, a submarine, maritime patrol aircraft P8I and Dornier, ship-borne helicopters and fighter aircraft. JMSDF will be represented by the guided missile destroyer JS Samidare and its integral helicopters.
- The exercise will be conducted over six days in two phases a Harbour Phase at Visakhapatnam comprising professional, sports and social interactions, after which, the two navies will jointly hone their warfighting skills at sea and enhance their interoperability through complex multi-discipline operations in the surface, subsurface and air domains.

Gujarat govt doubles insurance cover under Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya scheme

- In Gujarat, the state government has doubled the insurance cover under Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Yojana from the 11th of July. Now, the beneficiaries of PMAY will get an insurance cover of Rs 10 lakhs instead of the earlier 5 lakhs.
- Talking to the media, the State Health Minister Rushikesh Patel said the decision will benefit nearly 1.78 crore Ayushman Bharat card holders in the state. He added that the beneficiaries will get a free of cost medical treatment over two thousand government hospitals and 795 private hospitals in the state under PMAY
- AIR correspondent reports more than 39 lakh claims have been received in Gujarat under PMAY. The state ranks fifth in the country in terms of number of claims and has secured second position in terms of amount of claims cleared under PMAY so far. The claims worth over 2800 crore have been cleared in the state so far.

Indore Municipal Corporation to be the first urban body to get EPR credit

- Indore Municipal Corporation (IMC) in Madhya Pradesh, India, has made history by becoming the first urban body in the country to receive Extended Producers Responsibility (EPR) credit for recycling banned single-use plastic items.
- ndore has implemented a complete ban on single-use plastic items within the city. In recent times, the IMC seized approximately eight tonnes of such plastic, preventing its circulation. Moreover, Indore has also been recognized as India's cleanest city for the sixth consecutive year in the central government's annual cleanliness survey.
- EPR is an environmental policy approach in which a producer's responsibility for a product is extended to the post-consumer stage of a product's life cycle.
- Indore faces the daily challenge of managing a substantial amount of solid waste, with an average of 1,162 tonnes generated each day. This includes approximately 164 tonnes of plastic waste. However, the IMC has implemented an efficient waste collection system, where waste is categorized and collected from every doorstep in the city using civic vehicles. The collected waste is then promptly disposed of at the recycling plant, ensuring the city remains clean and environmentally sustainable.

NATO extends Jens Stoltenberg's tenure as chief of alliance by a year

- NATO's members, after struggling to find a replacement for the alliance head, extended Jens Stoltenberg's tenure for one more year.
- he announcement was made a week ahead of a summit of NATO leaders in Vilnius,
 Lithuania that will be mostly focusing on the Western military alliance's response to
 the conflict and Kyiv's push for membership.
- The 31 NATO countries decided to extend Stoltenberg's term after failing to agree on a replacement.
- The former prime minister of Norway, Stoltenberg has been the alliance's boss since 2014 and his tenure has already been extended thrice previously.
- He is widely seen as a steady leader and a patient consensus-builder across the alliance. He also won widespread appreciation for guiding the alliance throughout



former US President Donald Trump's presidency who openly conjectured about taking the US out of NATO.

MoU signed between India And Japan for the development of the Integrated Mast

- A Memorandum of Cooperation (MoC) for the development of the Integrated Mast United Combined Radio Antenna (NORA-50) was recently signed by Japan and India. Multiple antennas are included into the distinctive horn-shaped NORA-50 for tactical data link, TACAN (Tactical Air Navigation), and communications. By combining different antennas into a single structure, this integrated mast reduces the radar cross-section (RCS) and improves operational capabilities.
- The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between India and Japan represents the
 two nations' close strategic alliance and cooperative efforts in defence technology.
 Their common dedication to enhancing defence capabilities via collaborative
 research, development, and innovation is reflected in this. India and Japan are
 working together to create cutting-edge technologies that tackle shared defence
 issues and support regional stability.
- Modern warfare places a high value on the NORA-50, the Integrated Mast United Combined Radio Antenna. There are many benefits to combining antennas into a single structure. First, it lowers the RCS, which makes the platform harder for enemy radar systems to identify. In order to reduce the vulnerability of military assets and increase mission success rates overall, this improved stealth capabilities are essential.

Fourth edition of Space Economy Leaders Meeting under India's G20 presidency begins in Bengaluru

- As part of India's G20 Presidency, the fourth edition of the Space Economy Leaders Meeting began in Bengaluru today, July 6. Addressing the delegates during the inaugural event, Union Minister Dr. Jitendra Singh said that under Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the Indian Space programme's benefits were extended to neighbouring friendly countries and as part of space sector reforms, the private partnership was encouraged in this sector. He said that due to this decision, 140 start-ups have come up by successfully contributing to the Indian space programme.
- Jitendra Singh said that the space programmes in the country have experienced a
 quantum jump in the last eight to nine years. India is today a frontline nation
 through its Candrayaan and Gaganyaan programmes.
- The two-day meeting on the theme 'Towards a New Space Era has participation from the Heads of National Space Agencies, leaders of space industries of G20 Countries and various guest nations. It will discuss the responsibilities of the space faring nations for an enhanced share of space economy in the global economy. The Chairman of ISRO Somnath S, IN-SPACe Chairman Dr. Pawan Goenka and G20 Sherpa Amitabh Kant also spoke on the occasion.



DGCA, EASA ink MoU on drone standards, will work on training programmers

- The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA), has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) to jointly develop standards for drones.
- These standards will be related to licensing of personnel, training, air traffic management and infrastructure, and Unmanned Aircraft System Traffic Management (UTM) services
- Additionally, the DGCA and EASA will collaborate on conducting conferences, workshops, and training programmers in the area.
- In April this year, the DGCA signed a letter of intent (LoI) on 'Unmanned Aircraft Systems' and 'Innovative Air Mobility' with the (EASA) during the EU-India Aviation Summit held in New Delhi.
- The MoU will also ensure regular information sharing between the two authorities on the technological developments and research in this area and also their respective strategies for outreach to relevant stakeholders,
- DGCA said the signing of the MoU will enable harmonised standards and growth of the drone sector in the country.

Bank of India rolls out Mahila Samman Savings Certificate

- State-run Bank of India launched the Mahila Samman Savings Certificate scheme at all its branches. The Mahila Samman Savings Certificate is a government-guaranteed limited-period small savings scheme aimed at empowering women and fostering their financial inclusion,
- The scheme was announced by Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman during her Budget speech this year. The scheme offers an interest rate of 7.5 per cent per annum, compounded quarterly.
- Under the scheme, individual girls or women can open a Mahila Samman Savings
 Certificate, or a guardian can open an account on behalf of a minor girl.
- The account will mature after two years from the date of opening. Accounts under this scheme can be opened until March 31, 2025.

IDFC First Bank to Merge with IDFC Ltd in 155:100 Share Exchange Ratio

- IDFC First Bank and IDFC Ltd have announced their merger plans, with a share exchange ratio of 155 equity shares of IDFC First Bank for every 100 equity shares of IDFC. The merger aims to simplify the corporate structure, increase the book value per share, and streamline regulatory compliances. The merger is expected to be completed in the current financial year, subject to unforeseen circumstances.
- In March 2023, IDFC Ltd and IDFC Financial Holding Company Ltd appointed Axis Capital Ltd to determine the fairness of the share exchange ratio for the merger. The companies have completed all stages of corporate simplifications, with the amalgamation with IDFC First Bank being the next step. To facilitate the merger, registered valuers and legal experts were appointed to provide recommendations and conduct due diligence.



 The merger is expected to increase the book value per share of IDFC First Bank by 4.9 percent, based on audited financials as of March 31, 2023. It will consolidate IDFC FHCL, IDFC Limited, and IDFC First Bank into a single entity, simplifying the corporate structure. Additionally, the merger will result in a diversified shareholder base, similar to other large private sector banks, with no promoter holding.

Once it was decided that Indian cricket needed a chairman with a stronger profile than Shiv Sundar Das (23 Tests), who had been serving as interim head, the board officials found it tough to get a replacement from North Zone which Sharma had represented.
- Agarkar, a veteran of 191 ODIs and 26 Tests, was the frontrunner for the position
 after being interviewed by the Cricket Advisory Committee which consists of
 Sulakshana Naik, Ashok Malhotra and Jatin Paranjape. Agarkar, who has picked 349
 international wickets in a career lasting nine years boasts a strong resume, having
 earlier prospered in the limited administration roles assigned to him. From 2017 to
 2019, Agarkar served as Mumbai' chairman of selectors and was part of the Delhi
 Capitals along with coach Ricky Ponting and director of cricket Souray Ganguly.

SAFF Championship Final: India win 9th title, beat Kuwait

- India defeated Kuwait by 5-4 in the penalty shootout of the final of the South Asian Football Federation (SAFF) Championship at the Sree Kanteerava Stadium in Bengaluru. The match ended 1-1 in regulation time of the summit clash, which led to players from both the sides to take penalty shots from the spot for the coveted title.
- After five rounds of penalty kicks, the scoreline remained 4-4 and sudden death rule was applied.
- Mahesh Naorem scored but Sandhu saved Kuwait captain Khaled Hajiah's shot to the wild celebration of the home fans and at the India dug out.
- In the regulation time, Shabaib Al Khaldi had put Kuwait in the lead in the 14th minute before Lallianzuala Chhangte equalised in the 39th minute.

- Durand Cup Tournament The Durand Cup, the world's third oldest and Asia's oldest football tournament, was first held in the year 1888 at Dagshai (Himachal Pradesh).
- It was named after Mortimer Durand, who was then the Foreign Secretary in charge of India. The tournament was initially held for British soldiers, but was later opened to civilians. Mohun Bagan and East Bengal are the most successful teams in the history of the Durand Cup having won it sixteen times.

Defence ministry inks Rs 2,725 cr contract with MDL for refit of submarine

India's first 'Police Drone Unit' launched in Chennai

- In what is believed to be first of its kind initiative in India, Greater Chennai Police on Thursday established a 'Drone Police Unit' to assist cops in aerial surveillance. This will particularly be helpful in case of large gatherings, real-time checking of vehicle registration data and spotting of suspects.
- The project, which costs approximately Rs 3.6 crore according a press release by the GCP, was inaugurated by outgoing Tamil Nadu Director General of Police (DGP) C Sylendra Babu, in the presence of Chennai Police Commissioner Shankar Jiwal at Besant Avenue, Adyar.
- According to the police, a total of nine drones under three categories are available in this unit: Quick Response Surveillance Drones (6), Heavy Lift Multirotor Drone (1) and Long Range Survey Wing Place (2). These are all equipped with built-in artificial intelligence (AI) capabilities and can be operated up to a distance of 5-10 km from the ground station.

Neeraj Chopra clinches seco<mark>nd Diamond League title of the year wi</mark>th best throw of 87.66m

 Olympic gold medalist Neeraj Chopra obtained the top spot in Lausanne Diamond League 2023 with a best throw of 87.66 m. Virgin Galactic completes first manned mission to space:

- Virgin Galactic, the space venture established by British entrepreneur Richard Branson, has achieved a significant milestone as it successfully completed its first manned mission to the edge of space. The inaugural commercial flight, which took place on June 29, marks a momentous achievement for Virgin Galactic after two decades of dedicated efforts
- he mission featured two Italian Air Force personnel who were funded by the
 organisation. Colonel Walter Villadei, who is also slated for a future paid SpaceX
 mission to orbit, and Lieutenant Colonel Angelo Landolfi, a physician trained as a
 crew surgeon for Russian cosmonauts, were among the passengers.
- Unlike its competitor Blue Origin, founded by Jeff Bezos, this particular mission had
 a research-oriented focus rather than catering to celebrities and affluent thrillseekers, according to CNN. Nevertheless, future flights by Virgin Galactic are
 anticipated to encompass a diverse array of high-profile clientele.
- The journey unfolded in multiple stages, commencing at Virgin Galactic's spaceport
 in New Mexico. The passengers boarded VSS Unity, which was securely attached
 beneath the wing of the enormous twin-fuselage mothership known as VMS Eve.

- His family relocated to Los Angeles in the 1950s, and Alan Arkin won scholarships to various Los Angeles drama colleges before dropping out to form a folk music band, The Tarriers, in 1955.

- Alan Arkin was also a member of Chicago's storied Second City improvisational troupe, and appeared on the big screen for the first time with The Tarriers in 1957's "Calypso Heat Wave."

- India is one of the fastest-growing large economies in the world. While the country's energy consumption per capita is only one-third of the global average, India's energy demand is expected to grow rapidly as the economy expands. This calls for a phasing down of fossil-based energy sources in line with India's goal of achieving net-zero by 2070.
- The industrial sector is the main driver for future growth of energy demand and emissions, and green hydrogen can play a critical role in initially decarbonizing the hard-to-abate industrial sectors, such as fertilizer and refinery industries, and later heavy industries, including iron and steel. India has achieved impressive progress in renewable energy installed capacity and a decline in costs. Scaling up the production of renewable energy will accelerate the transition to low-carbon electricity and support the emergence and expansion of the green hydrogen sector.
