US and Papua New Guinea signed a defense pact

The United States and Papua New Guinea have signed a new bilateral defense cooperation agreement — a move that has sparked controversy in the Pacific Island nation and comes as Washington and China jostle for influence in the region.

US Secretary of State Antony Blinken and Papua New Guinea (PNG) Prime Minister James Marape signed the pact and a maritime security agreement during Blinken's visit to the capital Port Moresby

Advance text of the agreements were not released by either side, but the new defense cooperation was expected to expand US access to military and other facilities in PNG, bolstering Washington's security ties in the South Pacific.

Centre signs agreement with 6 states to start digital crop survey

The Center government has signed an agreement with six states of Assam, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh to start digital crop survey.

The Digital Crop Survey is part of the government's Agristack or India Digital Ecosystem for Agriculture (IDEA). It was launched in 2020. The agreement was signed at a workshop organized by the Union Ministry of Agriculture to discuss the implementation plan of digital crop survey with the state governments. On the occasion, web portal and mobile application manual for digital crop survey was unveiled.

The workshop discussed the implementation plan of Digital Crop Survey, benefits to various stakeholders, responsibilities of Central Government. The workshop also emphasized on the expectations from the states and support from the Center for effective and successful implementation of Digital Crop Survey.

Govt to issue special commemorative coin of ₹75 to mark the inauguration of new Parliament building

The government will issue a commemorative coin with the denomination of ₹75 to mark the opening of the new Parliament Building. Though commemorative coins are considered legal tender, they are not released for general circulation. One can source them from the specified agencies.

Appearance - The face of the coin will bear the lion capitol of Ashoka Pillar in the centre with the legend 'Satyamev Jayate' inscribed below, flanked on the left periphery with the word 'Bharat' in Devnagri script and on the right periphery with the word 'India' in English.



It shall also bear the Rupee symbol '₹' and denominational value '75' in the international numerals below the lion capitol. On the reverse face, the coin shall bear the image of Parliament complex.

Magnus Carlsen Won 2023 Superbet Rapid and Blitz Poland

World Chess Champion Magnus Carlsen won the 2023 Superbet Rapid & Blitz Poland, the second leg of the Grand Chess Tour (GCT) at the Museum of the History of Polish Jews. GM Magnus Carlsen and GM Jan-Krzysztof Duda fought a memorable and thrilling final round of the Superbet Poland Rapid & Blitz 2023, where the former held his nerve to hold a draw and win the event with a score of 24 points and pocket the top prize of \$40,000 and 13 Grand Chess Tour points. Duda finished second with 23 points for \$30,000 and 10 GCT points, while GM Wesley So and GM Maxime Vachier-Lagrave tied for third and fourth places with 21.5 points to pocket \$22,500 and 7.5 GCT each.

Carlsen began the fifth and final day where he left off from the previous day, extending his winning streak to 7/7. At one point, he even scored a blistering 10.5 points from 11 games between the 14th to 24th rounds. He overtook the overnight leader Duda by the 20th round and extended his lead to two points by the 23rd round. However, Duda caught up to just a point below him at the end of the penultimate round, and Carlsen fended off a spirited challenge from Duda in the final round to draw the game and finish a point ahead of the rest of the field.

Tina Turner 'Queen of rock 'n' roll' passes away

Tina Turner, the pioneering rock'n'roll star who became a pop behemoth in the 1980s, passes away at the age of 83, She died peacefully after a long illness in her home in Küsnacht near Zurich, Switzerland,

Turner began her career in the 1950s during the early years of rock 'n' roll and evolved into an MTV phenomenon.

About: Tina Turner - Tina Turner was an American-born Swiss singer. Known as the "Queen of Rock 'n' Roll", she rose to prominence as the lead singer of the Ike & Tina Turner Revue before launching a successful career as a solo performer. Turner began her career with Ike Turner's Kings of Rhythm in 1957. Turner also helded a Guinness World Record for the largest paying audience (180,000 in 1988) for a solo performer.

Turner won a total of 12 Grammy Awards. These awards include eight competitive Grammy Awards; she shares the record (with Pat Benatar) for most awards given for Best Female Rock Vocal Performance. Three of her recordings, "River Deep – Mountain High" (1999), "Proud Mary" (2003), and "What's Love Got to Do with It" (2012) are in the Grammy Hall of Fame.

Jawaharlal Nehru Death Anniversary

The death anniversary of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru is observed on 27 May every year. Prime Minister Narendra Modi also paid tributes to the first Prime Minister Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru on his 59th death anniversary.

Jawaharlal Nehru had a prominent role in India's freedom struggle. He also went on to become India's first Prime Minister after independence in 1947.

In order to free India from British rule, Mr Nehru fought against the British and was among the key leaders of the Indian National Congress (INC). On May 27, 1964, the first Prime Minister of India took his last breath. He was the PM from 1947 to 1964 till he died at the age of 74. He had a great fondness for kids, and children use to call him Chacha Nehru. Mr Nehru's birth anniversary on November 14 is also celebrated as Children's Day every year in India.

RBI Approves Merger of Maratha Sahakari Bank With The Cosmos Co-operative Bank
In a significant development, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has granted its approval for
the voluntary amalgamation of Maratha Sahakari Bank, based in Mumbai, with The Cosmos
Co-operative Bank Limited, located in Pune.

This appr<mark>oval comes under the authority vested in the RBI by Sub-Section (4) of Section 44A, in conjunction with Section 56 of the Banking Regulation Act, 1949.</mark>

The sanctioned scheme of amalgamation is set to take effect from May 29, 2023. Following the merger, all the branches of Maratha Sahakari Bank Ltd., situated in Mumbai, will operate as branches of The Cosmos Co-operative Bank Limited, located in Pune, starting from the aforementioned date. Maratha Sahakari Bank was under RBI's restriction from August 31, 2016 with cap on deposit withdrawal.

Ireland to label alcoholic drinks with detailed health warnings

Ireland says it will become the world's first country to label alcoholic drinks with comprehensive health warnings, These health warnings, which include information about risks like cancer, have received support from the World Health Organization and have been approved by both the European Union and the World Trade Organization. The new policy,



which will be implemented starting from May 22, 2026. This three-year period aims to allow businesses enough time to adjust to the new public health guidelines. Ireland made progress in implementing the health warning labels after overcoming two major obstacles at the European Union and the World Trade Organization. Although the alcohol industry has made significant efforts to hinder the introduction of health warning labels on alcohol products due to their reluctance to disclose the dangers associated with their products to the public. For instance, key members of the European Commissioner for Agriculture's cabinet met with the alcohol giant Diageo shortly after the proposal for health warnings was submitted to the EU.

Amit Shah lays the foundation stone of Guwahati campus of National Forensic Science University (NFSU) in Assam

Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah laid the foundation stone of Guwahati campus of National Forensic Science University (NFSU) in Assam. Along with this, Shri Amit Shah also launched the web portal 'Assam Police Seva Setu' to make the services of the Assam Police more accessible and transparent for the people. A book written by Dr. J.M Vyas on the use of forensic science in judiciary was also released. Several dignitaries including the Chief Minister of Assam Shri Himanta Biswa Sarma were present on the occasion.

Under the leadership of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, the Government of India is establishing a network of National Forensic Science University across the country, the goal of the country in the direction of criminal justice is very clear that the conviction rate is to be taken ahead of the rate of developed countries, It is the world's 11th and the country's 10th NFSU centre, NFSU- Guwahati will benefit North-East India as well as many countries along the eastern border like Bangladesh, Bhutan, Nepal, Myanmar, Indonesia.

Arunachal Pradesh government to set up Institute for Transforming Arunachal with NITI Aayog

Arunachal Pradesh government will set up Institute for Transforming Arunachal (ITA) with the help of NITI Aayog to take the development of the state to the next level. This was disclosed by Chief Minister Pema Khandu in a social media post. Mr Khandu held a meeting in Itanagar yesterday to discuss the formation of the ITA in presence of Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein. Mr Khandu said that the Institute for Transforming Arunachal would act as transformation leader for the state, provide assistance to various departments to advance their development strategies and unlock their potential. This will further boost the ease of living for the people and will have hassle-free access to various services. He said that leakages and spillovers will also be checked by bringing in more transparency and accountability in the system and service delivery mechanism.

MoCA launches UDAN 5.1, designed for helicopter routes

Following four successful rounds of the Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) - Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik (UDAN) and with the version 5.0 of the fifth round underway, the Ministry of Civil Aviation has launched UDAN 5.1 to further enhance the connectivity to remote areas of the country and achieve last mile connectivity through helicopters.



In a first for RCS-UDAN, this round specifically focuses on helicopter routes, offering new opportunities for operators to expand their operations. One notable change is that routes will now be permitted even if only one of the origin or destination locations is in a priority area, compared to the previous requirement of both points being in priority areas. To make helicopter travel more affordable, airfare caps have been reduced by up to 25 percent for passengers. Additionally, Viability Gap Funding (VGF) caps for operators of both single and twin-engine helicopters have been significantly increased, aiming to enhance the financial viability of operating the awarded routes.

CM Pinarayi Vijayan declares Kerala as total e-governance state

Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan declared the state as a total e-governance state. The chief minister made the declaration at an event organised by the Kerala IT Mission held in Thiruvananthapuram. district, Kerala has achieved this milestone through a series of policy initiatives aimed at transforming the state into a digitally-empowered society. IAMAI has also announced that Rajesh Magow, co-founder and group CEO of MakeMyTrip, and Satyan Ganjwani, vice chairman of Times Internet, have been elected the vice chairman and the treasurer of the association. The two will replace Shivnath Thukral, Meta's director and head of India public policy, and Harshil Mathur, CEO and co-founder Razorpay, The new 24-member Governing Council and the new Executive Council of the IAMAI will take charge from the present councils at the upcoming Annual General Meeting. The IAMAI Governing Council election is held every two years. Eighty-three members of the IAMAI contested the elections this year following the end of the two-year tenure of the previous council.

India, ADB sign \$141.12 million loan for industrial corridor development in Andhra Pradesh

The Indian government and the Asian Development Bank (ADB) on Thursday signed a \$141.12 million loan agreement aimed at supporting the development of high-quality internal infrastructure in three industrial clusters in the state of Andhra Pradesh. The loan will be utilized to enhance road networks, water supply systems, and electricity distribution networks, fostering industrialization and job creation in the targeted areas. The funds will be utilized to strengthen industrial infrastructure in the Visakhapatnam node, including the development of internal infrastructure in the Rambilli and Nakkapalli industrial clusters spanning 160 hectares and 441 hectares, respectively. By adopting a multi-sectoral approach, the ADB financing aims to boost manufacturing, improve competitiveness, and increase the manufacturing sector's contribution to Andhra Pradesh's gross domestic product.

P M Narendra Modi flags off Uttarakhand's first Vande Bharat Express train

Prime Minister Narendra Modi flagged off the inaugural run of Vande Bharat Express train from Dehradun to Delhi through video conferencing. This will be the first Vande Bharat to be introduced in Uttarakhand. The Prime Minster will also dedicate the newly electrified rail line sections in Uttarakhand. The state will have its entire rail route 100 percent electrified with this. Trains run by electric traction on the electrified sections will result in increase in speed of trains and enhance haulage capacity.

The 'Kavach' -Automatic Train Protection System, an indigenous Indian automatic train protection system, is installed in every Vande Bharat train, which boosts the train's overall security parameter. Further, the trains are environment friendly in various ways.

Sreeshankar wins gold, Jeswin takes silver at International Jumping Meeting in Greece Murali Sreeshankar and Jeswin Aldrin made it one-two for India in men's long jump at the International Jumping Meeting, a World Athletics Continental Tour bronze level event, in Kallithea, Greece,

Sreeshankar grabbed gold with a season-best of 8.18m (wind speed: +0.6m/s) in his final attempt. The 24-year-old, who won silver at the Commonwealth Games in Birmingham last year, started with a jump of 7.94m before recording 8.17m, 8.11m, 8.04m and 8.01m in the following attempts. He had won the gold last year aswell with a best jump of 8.31m. Jeswin finished second and grabbed silver with 7.85m (wind speed: 0.5m/s). The 21-year-old, who is the national record-holder, started with 7.81m before achieving his best in the second attempt. His next three jumps read 7.74m, 7.74m and 7.79m while the last one resulted in a foul.

Jeswin set a new national record of 8.42m at the Indian Open Jumps Championships at the Inspire Institute of Sports, Bellary, early this year in March. With that jump, he also qualified for 2023 World Athletics Championships.

Al Supercomputer 'AIRAWAT' puts India among top supercomputing league

The AI Supercomputer 'AIRAWAT', installed at C-DAC, Pune has been ranked 75th in the world. It was declared so in the 61st edition of Top 500 Global Supercomputing List at the International Supercomputing Conference (ISC 2023) in Germany. It puts India on top of AI Supercomputing nations worldwide. The system is installed under National Program on AI by Government of India.

The AIRAWAT PoC of 200 AI Petaflops integrated with PARAM Siddhi – AI of 210 AI Petaflops gives a total peak compute of 410 AI Petaflops Mixed Precision and sustained compute capacity of 8.5 Petaflops (Rmax) Double Precision. The peak compute capacity (Double Precision, Rpeak) is 13 Petaflops."

Justice S Vaidyanathan appointed as acting chief justice of Madras High Court

President Droupadi Murmu appointed Justice S Vaidyanathan as the Acting Chief Justice of Madras High Court, with effect from May 25, The appointment comes after the retirement of present Acting Chief Justice T Raja.

S Vaidyanathan is expected to perform the duties of Chief Justice until the Centre decides on Supreme Court Collegium's recommendation to appoint a Chief Justice for Madras HC. The SC has recommended the appointment of Bombay High Court's Additional Chief Justice SV Gangapurwala as the Chief Justice of Madras High Court.

About: S Vaidyanathan – Justice S Vaidyanathan was born on August 17, 1962 in Coimbatore. He did his schooling at Singaram Pillai High School in Villivakkam. He received an economics degree from DG Vaishnav College in 1982 and got BL degree from Madras Law College (now known as Dr. Ambedkar Government Law College).

Tamil Nadu government signs six MoUs with Singapore

Tamil Nadu government agencies and various organisations in Singapore signed six memoranda of understanding (MoUs) in the presence of Chief Minister M K Stalin and Singapore's Minister for Transport and Minister in-charge of Trade Relations, S Iswaran. Guidance Tamil Nadu, the investment promotion agency of the State government, and Singapore Indian Chamber of Commerce and Industries have signed an MoU for research and development (R&D) initiatives, collaboration between universities, government and private players, as well as assistance in exports from companies in Tamil Nadu. The unit will potentially generate employment opportunities for over 700 persons. Another MoU was signed with the Singapore University of Technology and Design for technology transfer.



The State Industries Promotion Corporation of Tamil Nadu (SIPCOT) signed an MoU with Singapore-India Partnership Office (SIPO) for cooperation between the two. Another MoU was signed between SIPO and FaMe TN (Facilitating MSMEs of Tamil Nadu) and Tamil Nadu Startup and Innovation Mission (TANSIM) towards technical education and start-ups. Further, the Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation signed an MoU with ITE Education Services for technology transfer and skill development.

The visit of these ships signifies the beginning of the harbor phase of the second edition of the naval exercise between the two nations, known as 'AL-MOHED AL-HINDI 2023.' This year, the naval exercise also includes the participation of a maritime patrol aircraft. The inaugural edition of the exercise was successfully conducted in 2021. Commissioned on November 9, 2012, INS TARKASH is a state-of-the-art stealth frigate of the Talwar class. Equipped with advanced weapon-sensor technology, the vessel possesses the capability to address threats in all dimensions. Its design incorporates stealth technologies and a specialized hull for reduced radar cross-section.

Accompanying INS TARKASH is the INS SUBHADRA, a patrol vessel of the Sukanya class. This

vessel has served as a test bed for the Dhanush ship-launched ballistic missile, as well as associated stabilization and launch platforms.

Bhupender Yadav Inaugurates Centre of Excellence on Sustainable Land Management in Dehradun

The Prime Minister of India during the 14th Conference of the Parties (COP-14) of the United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD) on 9th September 2019,

India's First Commercial Flight Powered By Indigenous Sustainable Aviation Fuel Flies From Pune To Delhi

India's first commercial passenger flight using indigenously produced Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) blend was successfully flies From Pune To Delhi.

Flight I5767 flew from Pune to Delhi powered by SAF blended aviation turbine fuel (ATF) supplied by Indian Oil Corporation Ltd (IOCL) in partnership with Praj Industries, which provided the technology for the blend.

Praj Industries has developed the fuel in partnership with the US-based biofuels company Gevo Inc., which has developed a breakthrough alcohol-to-jet (ATJ) technology for the production of SAF using sugarcane molasses as feedstock. The SAF samples produced at Praj Industries' research & development facility underwent detailed testing at IOCL laboratories before being cleared for the special flight.

Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) - SAF is a biofuel used to power aircraft that has similar properties to conventional jet fuel but with a smaller carbon footprint. Depending on the feedstock and technologies used to produce it, SAF can reduce life cycle GHG emissions dramatically compared to conventional jet fuel.
